Solving Numerical Problems

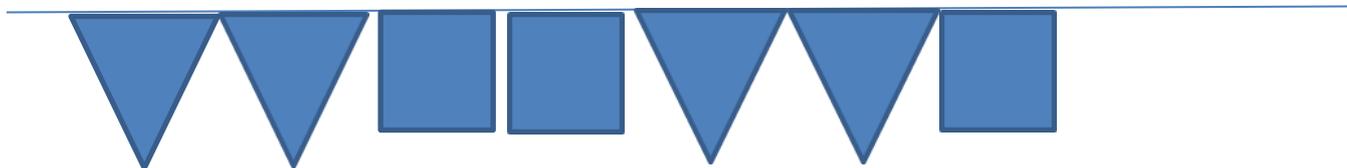
Shape and Measures

$$10 - 2 = 8$$

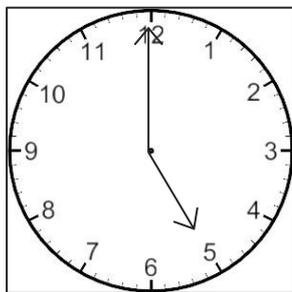
Find three more ways to make 8. Write your answers on the lines.

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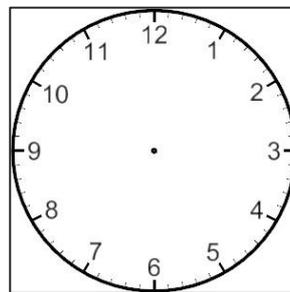
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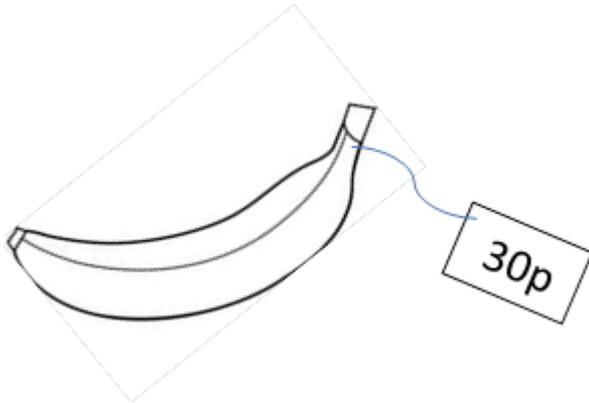
3. Tom and his Dad are going to the cinema. It is now 5 o'clock. The film starts two hours later. Draw the time the film starts on the second clock.

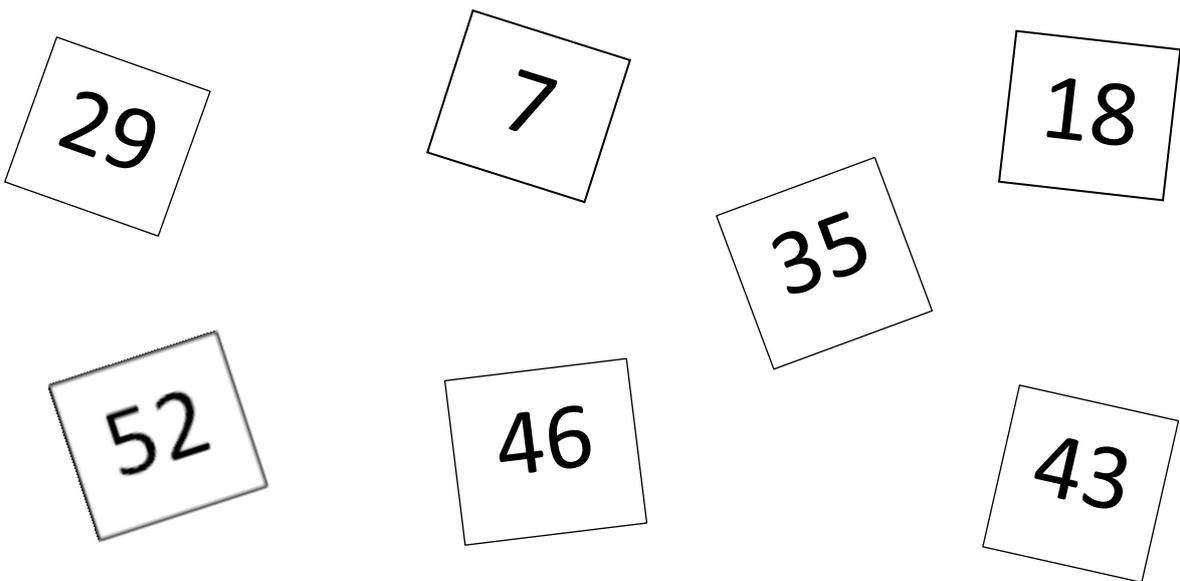


4. Emma has 50p. She buys a banana for 30p. How much does Emma have left? Write your answer on the line.
