This is where you develop your restaurant review with detailed information regarding food and atmosphere.		
Have you written at least two paragraphs, providing engaging and vivid details that bring the food and atmosphere in the restaurant to life? Have you continued to offer your opinion and the opinions of those in your dining group?	Vivid and engaging details describe the atmosphere (gastro pub) and food (vegan Mexican). Sensory description brings the scene to life. Personal opinions and the opinions of those in the dining group are offered.
